Rules / Rialacha

- 1. Feis registered with An Coimisiún le Rinci Gaelacha.
- 2. Age reckoned from 1st January, 2023.
- 3. Persons may not approach the adjudicator.
- 4. Objections, in writing, accompanied by a fee of €20 must be lodged within 10 minutes of the results.
- 5. The Committee will not be responsible for articles lost, damaged or stolen.
- 6. No Camcorders, videoing or flash photography is permitted during the competitions.
- 7. It is a rule of An Comhairle Chonnachta that all Bungrád and Tusgrád competitors, regardless of their region of residence, wear a class costume or a simple skirt/top or dress. It is not permissible to wear fake tan, makeup or wigs in these grades. Makeup and costume rulings effective from March 2014.
- 8. Where there are less than 6 competitors in any competition the winner will not be moved to the next grade.
- 9. The Committee as far as is practical will provide a stage surface suitable for dancing. However the committee cannot accept any liability whatsoever for injuries sustained while on stage. The lodgement of any entry will be deemed to be an acceptance of the provision by a dancer and by his/her parent/guardian.
- 10. Medals will be given to each competitor in the Reel Competition. Sashes given to all Championship & Trophy Reel winners.

The approval of this syllabus is simply to ensure that the number of dances, number of competitions etc..listed therein, adhere to the rules and regulations of Comhairle Chonnachta and An Coimisiún le Rince Gaelacha. It is important to highlight, that during the Covid 19 pandemic, it is solely the responsibility of the organisers to ensure that all feiseanna abide by the relevant advice and directive of the government, HSE and public health authorities in force at the time of the event.
